DISTRICT 1 MINUTES FOR MAY May 5, 2016 at the Roy Baptist Church

Reading of the traditions and concepts: Matt read the traditions; Lisa the concepts.

Approval of Minutes: Robert moved for approval of the minutes; Michelle seconded. The vote was unanimous.

Group Reports

Alateen attendance is good in Clearfield but still not catching on in Logan. The rest of the groups are doing well, are self-supporting with no issues.

Business:

- 1. Elections: There are several parts to this discussion:
 - a. <u>Area</u>: Area elections are held every three years and will be held this September 24th in Salt Lake City. As only sitting GRs or their designees are allowed to vote, it's kind of a big deal. Whenever a GR misses the voting meeting, we decrease district one's voice by one.
 - b. <u>District</u>: We have two issues here in that there was never an opportunity for someone to stand for DR and alternate DR when Cory and Tricia abandoned the positions AND the positions are in their 3rd years now so Secretary, Treasurer and Alateen Coordinator need to be replaced.
 - i. First of all, please go back to your groups and announce that we have 2 open positions and that if anyone would like to stand for them, they should show up at the June meeting and stand. At that time, the GRs can vote. This will be to fill the vacant position until the end of the year. If no one stands, the secretary will continue fill the responsibilities until the end of the year.
 - ii. Secondly, we need to hold elections for the upcoming term. MOTION: Chris made a motion that district elections be held in August so that newly elected members can go to fall assembly with the incumbent, shadow the incumbent at district meetings and learn how things work and not feel so lost when they take over the position in January. Robert seconded. The vote was unanimous. Meanwhile, Michelle and Chris will try to find the job descriptions/requirements from 3 years ago and get those out so the groups can study them and members can decide if they would like to run for a district position.
 - iii. What we did not discuss at this meeting and perhaps we can hold it for the June meeting is do we want the district positions to be 2-year positions instead of 3-year positions? Would people be more interested in standing if it wasn't such a long commitment? If we pick 2 years, the next election would be in 2018.
 - c. **Groups**: There was an action item from last month for the GRs to talk to your groups about elections and decide what your group would prefer. Since groups are autonomous, they do not need to hold elections on the same cycle as the area or district. As the groups decide, we will update this table:
