WORKSHOPS: Two workshops have been held so far this year. The first, held in February, was a service workshop to teach the incoming GRs and treasurers the responsibilities of their office. It also explained the different levels of service for those who might be interested in a service position. The second workshop, held in April at the Red Barn in Farmington, introduced attendees to the AMIAS program and hoped to remove some of the mystique about this program that causes members to hesitate to apply. We have one more Alateen sponsor as a result. Another is waiting on fingerprints.

PUBLIC OUTREACH: Public Outreach in District 1 continues to be awesome, thanks to the fine work by the "J-mazing Duo": Joanna S and Janet V. They continue to coordinate introductory meetings at treatment centers. They have been contacting police stations, schools and treatment centers to spread the word. Janet is looking into holding a Public Outreach for Professionals workshop in the coming months.
