

AAPP Coordinator Report

- Our Area has 4 active Alateen groups
 - District 1 - 2 groups: Wisdom Kids, Monday night in Action
 - District 3 - 1 group: Wasatch Back Teens Empowered
 - District 8 - 1 group: Puzzle Room
- We have 28 active AMIAS plus one in the middle of the application process
- Out of the 28 AMIAS 24 have had fingerprints and a background check done within the last 2 years. So only 4 will need to update their prints in 2024.
 - (Some of the AMIAS who needed to update their fingerprints decided to not renew, hence the high number with updated prints, plus we have a lot of brand new AMIAS)
- The BCI has switched over to everything electronic. In the past we have mailed fingerprints and background consent forms physically but will now need to send them in electronically. When getting new and renewing prints done the BCI now requires that the AMIAS applicant will need to present a Live Scan Authorization form. Heather will be working with me on creating the form and will send it in to be approved.
 - With all of the forms now electronically it will simplify things so much. It will be a learning process, I will be getting with the DAP's and we will get how it needs to work all figured out.
