We received a request to look at the “Hosting Al-Anon/Alateen Area Assemblies and Conventions”. The guidelines committee met, via zoom, and felt that there were plenty of good guidelines within this section, but there are also opportunities to do better. At this assembly we will be discussing one of the things that the committee felt needed to be reinforced – Announcing the location of the Assemblies one year in advance.

We are also focusing on (within this guideline) ensuring that that we define the role and responsibilities of how the Alt. Delegate fits into the Host Committees. We will be suggesting minor changes to the sentence structure of a few paragraphs in this section of the guidelines.

We will be reaching out to members of the AWSC that are leading committees or on thought/Task force groups to make coordinated efforts to ensure within the guidelines that Delegates Day and UTAC do not cross over each other.

We will be updating the guidelines for UTAC and USAW as the task forces bring them to the assembly for vote. *We will update the status of USAW to show that it is no longer in a trial period.

At this time, I want to thank the committee members that are involved. Each brings value and insight that others may or may not have considered.
