

## Guidelines Committee

At the Fall 2024 Assembly a motion passed to enter the Utah Area Safety and Behavioral requirements for Al-Anon Members Involved in Alateen Service (AMIAS), Alateen Groups, Alateen members, and others in Alateen service, commonly known as ASBR, into the guidelines of the Area. You will find this on the website.

Since our last assembly we have been able to finalize the **Budget and Reimbursement & the Hosting Assemblies** guidelines. The GRs will be voting on these changes. A copy of the proposed guideline is available online, under events -spring assembly. \*note you will need to do a side-by-side comparison of the Budget & Reimbursement guidelines to see the changes (request a 'working' copy from Sheri prior to the assembly). The Hosting Assemblies changes are in red ink (there were only minor changes to this guideline).

At the spring assembly, we will be discussing the elections of new officers and coordinators that will be held in the fall and, in part, the Area Election Guideline and Procedures since we have voted to keep the assemblies hybrid. This will be the next guideline the committee tackles. We hope to have this guideline updated for voting prior to the Panel elections in the fall.

The USAW committee has put together their bylaws and procedures. Since they are their own entity the Area assembly does not need to vote on these, just be aware of them. They are now posted on the website for your review and will be placed with the Hosting Assemblies guidelines after the assembly.

UTAC has got a committee going on the bylaws and procedures for that event and we hope to reveal those soon. Again, they will not need to be voted on by the assembly, but rather members just need to be aware of them.
