

Archives Report  
Spring Assembly

As the new Archivist for Panel 66 I'm happy to report that the Utah Area Archive, both physical and digital have successfully past to me. I have inspected the physical archive and determined that the physical archive is stored in a manner consistent with the *Utah Area Archives Guideline*. With the help of the Area Chair I have also inspected the digital archive. There are continuing challenges accessing the digital archive. These challenges involve technical issues connecting AI-Anon coordinator email addresses with personal email addresses and resolving two level verification demands. I have been consulting with the Area Technology Coordinator to find solutions.

An Archive Committee was formalized at the Fall 2025 Assembly. This Committee consists of the Archivist, the Technology Coordinator, the Website Coordinator, and two interested AI-Anon members, one of who may act as the physical archive Custodian. The Archive Committee has not yet held its first meeting of the Panel, primarily due to the need to resolve technical questions about the digital archive. It is anticipated that the Committee will meet shortly after Spring Assembly.

A small Archive display is being prepared for Spring Assembly. This display is actually the most current physical Archive catalogue. The catalogue will also eventually be posted to the Area Website.

I am grateful for the opportunity to serve in this position and hope to find ways to make the Utah Area Archives accessible and meaningful for our AI-Anon members.
