As per our Area Guidelines, the finance committee led by our Area Treasurer, Leslie T., met to review the current Budget and Reimbursement Guideline. Previous discussion had occurred at Assembly to establish that the full payment would be made to send our Delegate to the WSC each year as our financial situation warrants. A vote will be made to reflect this abundant idea within our Guideline. The finance committee also put together a proposed
