The purpose of considering two locations was to make it easier for Group Representatives (GRs) throughout the state to attend and participate, especially for those who may have difficulty traveling long distances.

We decided to conduct a trial run with two separate locations. As with any new approach, there were both pros and cons. We would appreciate hearing your feedback about your experience with the two Delegate Days, including what worked well and what could be improved.

The GRs will have the opportunity to vote on how they would like to move forward with Delegate Day in the future. Your feedback and participation will help determine the best way to serve our Area.

I am also chairing a committee to gather and organize all Alateen processes and procedures into one central location.

The goal of this project is to make the information clear, organized, and easy to access for future Area Alateen Process Persons (AAPPs) and Alateen Coordinator. By bringing the information together in one place, we hope to provide continuity and make it easier for those taking on these service positions to understand their responsibilities and follow established processes. This is intended to create a useful resource that can be passed from one trusted servant to the next, providing better clarity and consistency in the future.

Looking ahead, I will also be helping to plan the Fall Assembly in 2027 in conjunction with Alcoholics Anonymous (AA). I look forward to working with AA as we plan this event and finding ways to support each other and find unity while honoring the traditions and principles of both programs.
